Problems to report

Street lights/sign lights not working – sign light on the roundabout to Cotford St Luke, first street light in to Kings Yard, street light no3 on Taunton Road, 2 street lights on the entrance to Station Green, street light no2 at Darby Way, street light on the footpath to the community hall

Drains are flooding at Quantock view

Drains blocked along Station Road by Greenway

In heavy rain the ditch along the road between Bishops Lydeard and Ash Priors is overflowing, I dug out what I could but this needs digging out properly

Works completed:

The railing along the top of the underpass was not connected properly. Every bolt was loose down one side (I sent a video to Amy to show how bad it was left) and the connectors that hold it together where in the wooded area near the underpass; luckily I found them when I was picking up litter. I have connected it all up and tightened all the bolts
